

# Real-Time Distance Learning

## How to succeed in your studies

Real-time distance learning means that the student studies remotely online for a specific, designated time under the guidance of a teacher. The course is interactive and requires participation. The learning environment is Zoom or Google Meet. Course materials are in Google Classroom.

### What do you need for the course

- a working computer, camera and microphone from day one
- the textbook
- a quiet space and time to study during lessons



### What we do in the course

- The teacher teaches in Finnish. The teacher may use English or other languages as auxiliary languages.
- The course requires active presence and participation in lessons
- During the course, you will talk to the teacher and your classmates. It is essential to turn on your camera and microphone during the course
- During the course, you will complete mandatory course assignments, take tests, and do homework.
- If you start the course late, please make arrangements with the course teacher in advance. Also notify the teacher if you will be absent from the course.
- The course requires the use of Zoom/Google Meet and logging into Classroom from the beginning of the course.

### Other instructions

- Translators or other aids can sometimes be used as a learning aid, but continuous use does not promote learning. Help is prohibited during tests unless otherwise agreed. Cheating or presenting someone else's work as your own is prohibited..
- Be kind to all group members and consider other students in the course.
- Please ensure that there is as little background noise (e.g. television, other people) as possible when your microphone is on.
